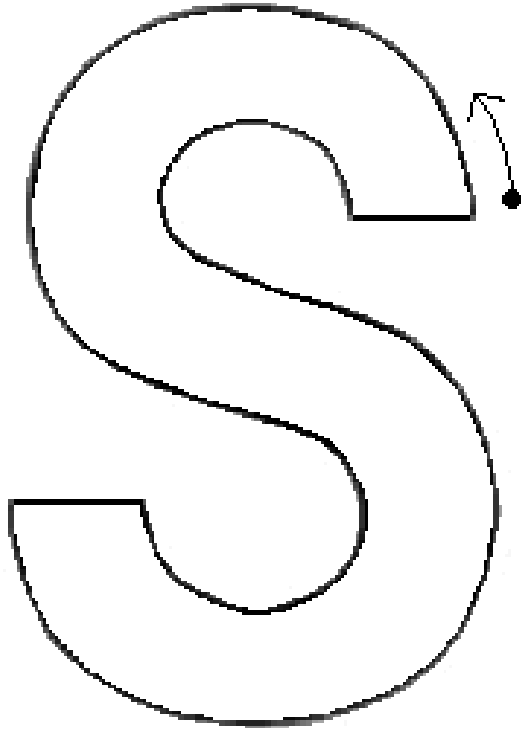


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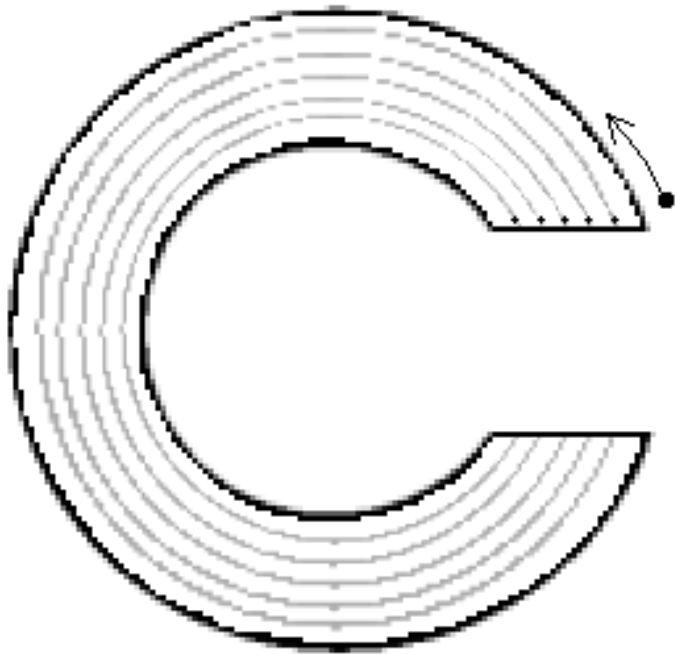

Learning the correct directions early helps to make the change to “joined” writing easier.



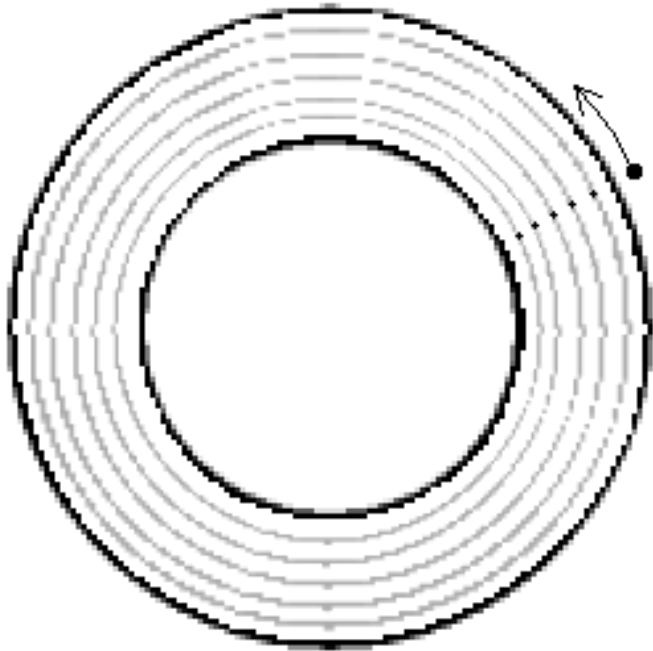
