Letter Rhymes is designed to empower parents, to help them lay a firm foundation for their children to learn to read successfully*.

Parents, grandparents, friends, older siblings, etc. can

- Help children identify the initial sound in words (phonemic awareness) – just find the pictures on each page.
- Extend children's vocabulary, and general knowledge, through interesting conversations and researching together to find answers to their questions – just talk about the pictures.
- Learn the most common sound of each letter, as opposed to its name or the many possible sounds (introductory phonics).

It is multisensory:

- Trace the letter – start at the dot, follow the arrows.
- Make the shape of the letter with hands or body – “Can you find the picture or pictures of the child doing this? Can you do it? Can Grandpa do it? At least one is impossible, even if you have a twin!”

The aim is to help children learn the key skills above in an interesting and engaging way, so that they can be successful when they come to learn to read.

It is important when you read the rhymes to say the sound of the letter, **not its name**.

E.g., /a/ (not “ay”) is for apple ... /mmmm/ (not “em”) is for mountain ...

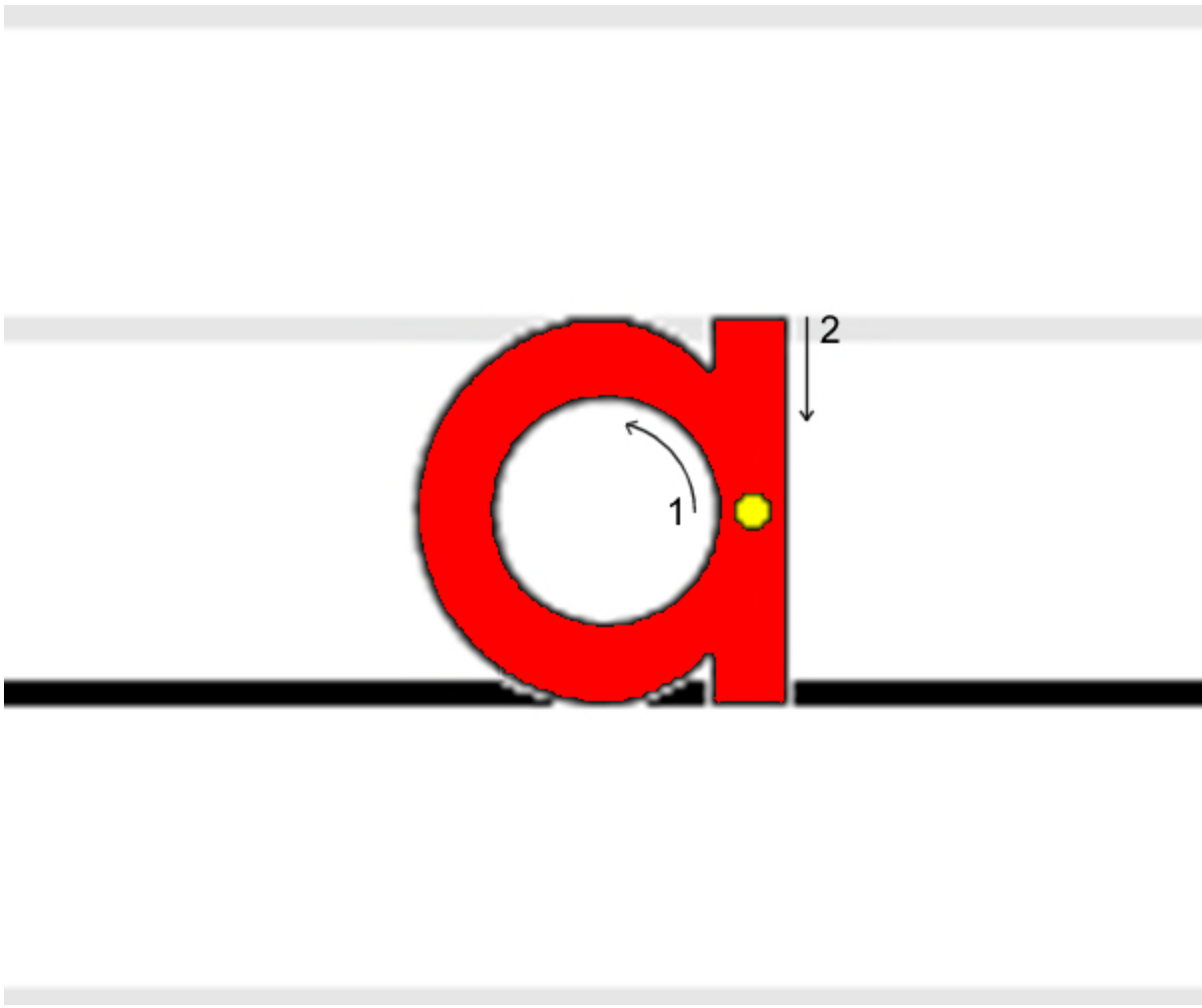
Make sounds long wherever possible – /mmm.../ not /muh/;
/nnn.../ not /nuh/; /fff.../ not /fuh/; /vvv.../ not /vuh/; /lll.../ not /luh/;
/rrr.../ not /ruh/; /sss.../ not /suh/; /zzz.../ not /zuh/.

If children already know the name of a letter, just say something like, “That’s good. That’s the name of the letter. Do you remember its sound?”

Most importantly, go at your child’s pace and follow their interests. If they are enjoying it, they will be learning. Keep sessions short. Try to stop just before they lose interest. Don’t make it too formal, just have fun together.

* Dr Ken Rowe, Committee Chair of The National Inquiry into the Teaching of Literacy conducted in Australia in 2005, listed five features of a successful reading program - phonemic awareness (the ability to hear and manipulate the sounds in oral language), phonics (the relationships between letters and sounds), fluency, vocabulary and text comprehension. He also stressed the importance of parents reading to their children, especially during the formative preschool years
