



Letter Rhymes

An Alphabet Book to Teach the Sounds of Letters, Third Edition

Letter Rhymes is an alphabet book that is full of interesting illustrations to capture children's attention, and prompt discussion that extends their vocabulary. The pictures on each page start with the most common sound of that letter, so children hear the initial sound of each word and associate it with the letter.

Each letter has a rhyme, and a related illustration, to help children remember the sound of the letter. So, it is important to read the rhymes and talk about the letters using their most common sound, rather than the name of the letter.

Letter Rhymes is multisensory. Children can trace each letter with a finger. Starting points and directions are marked. Also, they can make the letter with their hands or bodies, or imagine Mum, Grandpa, etc. trying to do it!

All in all, *Letter Rhymes* is fun for both adults and children as they explore together some adventures in laying a firm foundation for learning to read.
